

Homework Postponement Pass

Mr. Swango understands that, from time to time, events beyond the control of even the most organized and responsible students occur which prevent homework from being completed or submitted on time. Common causes of missing homework include (but are not limited to) temporary lapses in memory, family emergencies, unreasonably high volumes of other subject work, athletics/extra-curricular activities/jobs, and attacks by rabid paper-eating pigeons.

If you are unable to complete or submit your homework on time, you may submit the assignment late with this completed, signed, Homework Postponement Pass. All homework requirements must be satisfied—original problem is written down, all work shown, diagrams included when required.

NOTE: To avoid misuse of this homework pass privilege, Mr. Swango has established the following rules:

- The homework pass must be submitted within two weeks of the original due date.
- No more than 3 postponement passes may be submitted in a semester.
- At most 2 passes may be submitted in the week before the semester closes.
- Absolutely NO homework from previous semester will be accepted in a current semester.
